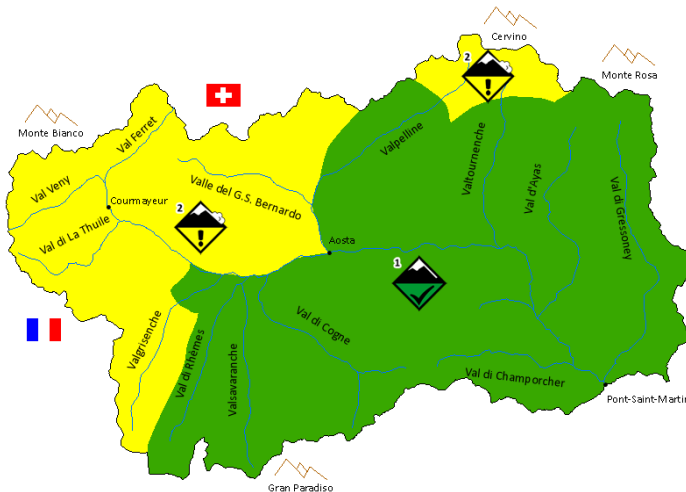


Avalanche danger forecast for Tuesday 3/1/2022

AVALANCHE DANGER

Weak layers in the old snowpack necessitate caution.

Areas with avalanche danger level 2-moderate
In some places the avalanches can be triggered in the faceted old snow and reach medium size in isolated cases. This applies especially in little used backcountry terrain. The avalanche prone locations are rather rare but are barely recognisable, even to the trained eye.
The wind slabs of the last few days are to be evaluated with care and prudence in very steep terrain.
Very isolated mostly small natural avalanches are not entirely ruled out.
Areas with avalanche danger level 1-low
Currently there are favourable conditions generally.
Individual avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular on extremely steep shady slopes. Mostly the avalanches are small.
Restraint should be exercised because avalanches can sweep people along and give rise to falls.

Less snow than usual is lying.

Below approximately 2000 m hardly any snow is lying.

The old snowpack will be well bonded on steep sunny slopes. As a consequence of falling temperatures and solar radiation the snow drift accumulations stabilised during the last few days.

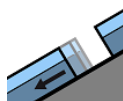
