



>cbr /></style></style>In some places the avalanches can be triggered in the faceted old snow and reach medium size in isolated cases. This applies especially in little used backcountry terrain. The avalanche prone locations are rather rare but are barely recognisable, even to the trained eye.
 />The wind slabs of the last few days are to be evaluated with care and prudence in very steep terrain.
 />Very isolated mostly small natural avalanches are not entirely ruled out.

GENERAL CONDITION updated at 2/28/2022

Less snow than usual is lying.

Below approximately 2000 m hardly any snow is lying.

The old snowpack will be well bonded on steep sunny slopes. As a consequence of falling temperatures and solar radiation the snow drift accumulations stabilised during the last few days.
